Requirements

University BA, BSc. or equivalent for those who need Standard Level 1 teaching from TESL Canada Federation. Or if the applicant does not have a university degree and wishes to register for this program, she/he will be accepted, but is not eligible for standard level 1 certification from TESL Canada. The graduates will receive their certificate from Canada College, enabling them to teach ESL courses anywhere in the world. The only difference is that those without a Bachelor's degree are not eligible to teach TESOL courses.
